Statement of Candidacy must be received by Friday, May 4th at 5pm.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Party Leader and Elected Official (PLEO) (13 PLEO Delegates)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Elected at the State Convention in Seattle on Sunday, June 3rd. Elected by state central committee members representing legislative districts. Individuals eligible to run for these positions include big city mayors and state-wide elected officials, state legislative leaders, state legislators, tribal leaders, and other state, county and local elected officials and party leaders. Statement of Candidacy must be received by Friday, May 25th at 5pm.
