

Resolution in Support of PCO Elections in Washington State

- 1 **WHEREAS** Washington's political system is more transparent and more democratic because we e 2 elect PCOs;
- 4 **WHEREAS** Washington's Legislature passed precinct committee officer election laws in 1907 to 5 prevent the political corruption of Tammany Hall and Boss Tweed, because PCOs are elected by
- 6 the voters in the precinct, not chosen by the Party boss;
- 8 **WHEREAS** elected PCOs are a source of stability for the Democratic and Republican (D and R) 9 parties; and
- 11 **WHEREAS** the election of PCOs every two years is the "re-set button" that allows us to re-12 organize our county and LD parties, electing their officers and state committee representatives,
- 13 who then control the state party;

- 15 **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that we call on the Auditor of Whatcom County to acknowl-16 edge the valuable role that elected PCOs play in Washington's democracy; and
- 18 **THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that we ask the Auditor of Whatcom County to call on the Washington Association of County Officials to work with the Republican and Democratic parties to find a sensible way to continue this important feature of our democracy.
